Tournament Highlights & Player Amenities

72 Hole Stroke Play (Cut after 54 Holes) for all Professionals and Open Division Amateurs (CUT low 20 for Pros; 24 low gross and 24 low net for open division amateurs)

Senior Division – 54 Holes (gross and net, for players 60 and over by or on 7/28 who declare gold tees) (players 75 and over may play the red tees)

54 Hole Pro-Am Team (1 pro & 3 amateurs, 3 net best balls of 4) for All Players Flights for All Amateurs

Included with the entry fee for all players: unlimited range balls for the week, practice round on Wednesday, July 30th, Saturday night dinner. Amateur entry includes rental cart.

Additional for the pros: \$25 fee for practice rounds prior to the Pro Qualifier, up to July 28th, which includes a golf car. Free practice round (pay for cart rental \$20) on Wednesday of the event. Limited complimentary housing available to professionals.

ALSO FEATURING: The Pro/Qualifier July 28th and 29th

This event is a 2 day official Dakotas Tour event for Professionals. This event will offer bonus pool points for the Tour and is the <u>only way for non-exempt Professionals to qualify for the Men's event</u> later in the week. **There is no other qualifier**. *This event is capped at 72 Professional entries*. Professionals play on Monday, Ladies play on Tuesday with the top 36 Pros. \$6,000 1st place Pro; \$22,000 Total Prize Money (based on full field).

PLAYER INFORMATION MUST REGISTER AT DAKOTASTOUR.COM

PROFESSIONALS

- All golf professionals must pay the Annual Dakotas Tour Fee. You may pay with credit card at www.dakotastour.com.
- Tournament entry fee is \$1,000 for Exempt professionals only wishing to play in the Men's Thursday-Sunday event. Tournament entry is \$1,400 for Exempt professionals wishing to play in both the Junior-Lady and Men's events.
- Non-exempt Pros are required to play in the Pro/Qualifier to qualify for the Men's event. The Non-exempt entry fee is \$1,500 which includes a non-refundable \$100 qualifier fee.
- 2 Day Pro/Qualifier: Non-exempt players who qualify are paid into the Men's Pro-Am. Players who do not qualify will receive a refund of \$1,000.
- Exempt pro entries must be entered online or by phone by to lock in their exemption.
- Any hole-in-one, pro or amateur, during tournament rounds will receive \$100.
- Ties for last place will be set accordingly to the Dakota Tours Guidelines.

AMATEURS

- PLAYERS HAVE THE OPTION TO FORM THEIR OWN 3 MAN TEAM. For this reason we urge you to get your entry in early.
- Amateurs who choose to form their own team cannot have a total index greater than 50. If a team entry
 totals more than 50, the team handicap will be adjusted for the team portion of the event only. Teams
 paired by the committee that exceed a total index of greater than 50 will not be adjusted for the team
 portion of the event.
- Amateurs not wanting to form their own team may enter as usual. If your entry is not included in a team entry, the amateur pairings are categorized into A, B, or C players by index, and one of each is included on each team to the best ability of the Committee.
- Amateur entry fee is \$350 for members of Hillcrest and \$450 for non-members of Hillcrest. All entries
 must be submitted with full payment.
- The fee includes all range balls for the week, a practice round on Wednesday, 54 holes of stroke play tournament golf, shared golf cart for non-members, dinner Saturday night, and if you are eligible for, and make the cut, another 18 holes on Sunday.
- All amateurs must have a GHIN number and index. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS. We will verify your index after the July 24th revision.
- For team and individual net purposes, all amateurs play at 85% of their established handicap. A maximum adjusted handicap of 30 will be allowed.
- The Hillcrest Pro-Am Committee reserves the right to make adjustments to handicaps to maintain the integrity of the tournament.
- Players will be pre-flighted based on handicap index.
- The low 24 gross and net amateurs, plus ties, will play on Sunday for overall gross and net champions. Additional prizes are awarded for Sunday's play only, separate from the flight prizes.
- The team portion of the tournament is based on the net scores of one pro and three amateurs per team. The Pro changes teams each day.
- Amateurs may indicate a preference for playing shift and the Committee will accommodate as much as possible. The shifts are Thursday morning, Friday afternoon, and Saturday morning, or Thursday afternoon, Friday morning, and Saturday afternoon.
- The Senior division and the Team event both conclude after 54 holes of play. Seniors are not eligible for Sunday play.
